

## Junior Faculty and Trainee Council 2016-2017 Interim Board Report

- Activities from May 2016 (ISHLT Annual Meeting) to Present
  - o Appointment of New Council Liaisons:
    - The council leadership reviewed over 60 nominations for council positions
    - A new liaison position for the Nursing, Health Science & Allied Health Council was created (Collen Mcilvennan)
    - For the Heart Failure, MCS, in Pediatric transplantation councils, we decided to initiate overlapping 2 year to terms for the liaison positions to ensure continuity of participation in these very busy councils. (i.e. MCS Council Liaison: 2017-2019 Feras Khaliel, 2018-2020 Jamie Hernandez)
  - Symposia Submission:
    - A noteworthy effort led by Martin Schweiger (Education Workforce Leader).
    - A record number of symposia (57!) as primary and collaborative submissions were reviewed by the council this year, despite a tighter than usual timeline.
  - o 7/26/16 JFTC conference call
    - Excellent participation
    - During this initial call with the new council liaisons, we discussed established and potential rolls for each position.
    - Liaisons were encouraged to reach out their respective Council leadership

- Moving Forward:
  - Expanding International Junior Faculty Involvement: I2C2 Workforce Liaison (<u>Hirsch Mehta</u>) and International Outreach Liaison (<u>Darko Vucicevic</u>) will create a data collection tool to identify barriers to international junior faculty/trainee participation in ISHLT.
  - o Increasing Involvement of Junior Faculty with the ISHLT endorsed guidelines: Develop mentoring or access pathway for Junior Faculty to participate in guideline development and authorship process. (Jose Nativi, S&G Liaison)
  - o **Increase JFTC participation from NHSAH members:** NHSAH Liaison (Mcilvennan) collecting preliminary data to understand outreach opportunities.
