Clinical practice

1. Discussion of challenging cases and clinical scenarios.
2. Service/program development. (e.g. how to set up novel service)

Research

1. Identifying potential research collaborators.
2. Grant applications (US and OUS) and opportunities for ISHLT awards.
3. Managing financial and commercial arrangements including potential conflicts of interest.
4. Securing *JHLT* reviewing/editorial roles.
5. Career guidance for pure research/clinician scientists.
6. Advice on project conception/manuscript/project writing/organization, editorial writing (general guidance, not the actual writing).

Digital

1. Advice on how to connect with the transplant community online (supported by ISHLT staff in addition to members)
2. Advice on how to engage with ISHLT digital output.

Career and Leadership

1. Career guidance for clinicians wishing to take on leadership roles in their institution or ISHLT.
