Elizabeth Hammond, MD, participated in groundbreaking clinical trials of induction T-Cell depletion in heart allograft recipients during the 1980's and 90's. She pioneered the diagnosis of humoral cardiac allograft injury, and significantly contributed to our understanding of its pathogenesis.

She is being honored for these important contributions to clinical and translational investigation in our field.
